**Tyler Baudhuin named 2026 Wisconsin  
Outstanding Young Farmer**

Door County farmer honored for outstanding commitment to agriculture.

WESTON, Wisconsin [Jan. 24, 2026] – The Wisconsin Outstanding Young Farmer (OYF) program is pleased to announce Tyler Baudhuin, Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin, was selected as the 2026 Wisconsin Outstanding Young Farmers during the 72<sup>nd</sup> Annual Awards Weekend Jan. 23-24, 2026 sponsored by Alcivia, Northside Elevator, Inc. and Riesterer & Schnell.

Tyler Baudhuin is the fourth generation on the Sturgeon Bay dairy farm where he helps operate in partnership with other family members.

He started his personal involvement in farming in 2014 when he purchased 46 acres of land. Since that time, he has become a partner in his family dairy that has recently been expanded to more than 300 cows.

Their total 900 acres of cropping land includes corn, alfalfa, soybeans, wheat, peas, oats and straw.
